Maternal, Newborn, and Child Health










The purpose of Healthy Start (HS) is to improve health outcomes before, during, and after pregnancy, and reduce racial/ethnic differences in rates of infant death and other "perinatal" outcomes.



Funder: Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA), an agency of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS)



## Theory of Change

To decrease infant mortality disparities in San Bernardino County, Black families must have access to services that are shown to improve birth outcomes, including midwifery care, mental health and lactation support, and doula services.

Because of the large geographic area, multiple points of access must be available, including in the high desert region.

To ensure a stronger infrastructure and sustainability, existing service providers should be identified, uplifted, and coordinated.

The upstream drivers of infant mortality must be addressed across a broad coalition of organizations who work collectively to identify, plan, and advocate for system level improvement.

# Midwifery-led Prenatal Groups

### Conduct

Conduct group activities intended to assist in early identification of high-risk pregnancies & early warning signs

#### Facilitate

Facilitate group discussions (curriculum will be provided)

### Offer

Offer opportunities for individual questions & scheduling postpartum and newborn assessments post Birth

### Include

Clinical checks will include health measurements such as blood pressure and weight checks, preeclampsia screening, fundal height measurement.



# IBCLC (or) Lactation Professional

Implement weekly new parent support group with assistance from the Care Coordinator

New parent support group activities include: 30 mins socialization, 30 mins of support.

Topics include: swaddling, safe sleep, breastfeeding techniques, positioning, latch, common breastfeeding challenges, etc.
