Overview


- Inland SoCal United Way 211+
 - Mission: improve health, housing, education, financial stability outcomes for all
 - Operates over 40+ programs
 - Assists over one million households in the region each year
- Guaranteed Income Pilot Program
 - In Partnership with the state, ISCUW is one pilot site implementing GI
 - Serving two groups: birthing people within 27 wks pregnancy (Riverside County); foster youth aging out of extended care at 21st birthday (Riverside and San Bernardino Counties)

GUARANTEED INCOME PILOT PROGRAM



Inland SoCal United Way is excited to launch the Guaranteed Income (GI) Pilot Program! This program will provide \$750 a month for 18 months to randomly selected former foster youth applicants who are turning 21 in the Inland region.

Program eligibility:

- Must be turning 21 years old at time of application (between January 25 and October 25, 2024)
- Must reside and be a former foster youth in Riverside or San Bernardino Counties
- Household income must be less than \$90,616 in Riverside County and less than \$88,847 in San Bernardino County
- Must be referred by a GI partner agency

GUARANTEED INCOME PILOT PROGRAM



Inland SoCal United Way is excited to launch the Guaranteed Income (GI) Pilot Program! This program will provide \$600 a month for 18 months to randomly selected pregnant applicants living in Riverside County.

Program eligibility:

- Must be 18 and older
- Must be within first 6 months of pregnancy at time of application
- Must reside in Riverside County
- Household income must be less than \$90,616 per year
- Must be referred by a GI partner agency

To apply for the program:

- Contact a GI partner agency
- Dial 211
- Call us at 951-289-3328
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GI for Birthing People

- Guaranteed Income \$600 a month for 18 months
- Two groups (500 GI and 500 comparison) randomly selected to get \$600 or \$20
- 1,000 spots available only 10% filled
- Must reside in Riverside County
- Must be 18 years or older
- Must be in their first 6 months of pregnancy (27 weeks)
- Household income of less than \$90,616
- Application period open through October 25, 2024

GI for Former Foster Youth

- Guaranteed Income \$750 a month for 18 months
- Two groups (120 GI and 120 comparison) randomly selected to get \$750 or \$20
- 240 spot available only 10% filled
- Must be turning 21 at the time of application (between January 25-October 25)
- Can apply 90 days before turning 21 or 30 days after turning 21
- Must have an open EFC case in Riverside or San Bernardino County at time of 21st birthday;
- Household income of less than \$90,616 (Riverside County), \$88,847 (San Bernardino County)

Note: no redetermination, self attestation, incarceration status and immigrations status etc not considered
