Purposely Chosen, Inc. is a 501(c)(3) corporation, founded in 2006 by Dretona Maddox. Its services aim to offer help, hope and healing to displaced minor parents in Riverside and San Bernardino counties. Our mission to help displaced teen moms keep their babies. We accomplish this mission by providing a safe haven for displaced and at-risk youth; particularly homeless, runaways, and abandoned pregnant and/or parenting adolescent girls, ages 13-21; to unreservedly come to have their basic needs met (i.e., shelter, food, water, love, and respect), and receive support, education, advocacy and access to community resources to ensure a healthy pregnancy and delivery. At Purposely Chosen, we hope that our services will enable these adolescents to discover their supreme purpose in life, overcome the obstacles of homelessness, and gain self-sufficiency.

Meet The Founder

Dr. Dretona T. Maddox is a distinguished Assistant Professor of Social Work at California Baptist University's College of Behavioral and Social Sciences. Her personal journey—marked by overcoming homelessness and teenage pregnancy and coping with the loss of her mom to suicide—has informed her academic and professional pursuits.

Dr. Maddox holds a BSN from the University of Phoenix, an MSW from the University of Southern California, and a DSW from California Baptist University. Her doctoral research focused on addressing the health inequities faced by pregnant Black teenagers.

A recognized authority in Black Adolescent Maternal Health, Dr. Maddox is deeply committed to enhancing the lives of at-risk communities. In addition to her scholarly work, she serves as the Founding President and CEO of Purposely Chosen, Inc., a non-profit dedicated to supporting pregnant and parenting teenagers in foster care. She has successfully established two maternity homes in Southern California's Inland Empire, offering crucial resources to young mothers.






The Goal
